Scholarship Requirements

The *Woman of Distinction Scholarship* is an annual scholarship awarded on a one-time basis to an incoming freshman woman that demonstrates a strong connection to community service and academic excellence, two key principles of Sigma Lambda Gamma. The award amount is \$500 to be used for tuition purposes and/or books. To qualify for the award, the applicant must be entering the University of Washington as a freshman for the 2016-2017 academic year. Each applicant will be evaluated based on both their academic success and their established commitment to community service. The award will be announced and presented to the individual during Spring Quarter 2017.

General Instructions

The following must be included in the application:

- 1. Complete application form
- 2. An unofficial University of Washington transcript
- 3. Personal essay (2 page maximum, double spaced)
- 4. One letter of recommendation from a teacher, counselor or community leader that can account for the applicant's outstanding commitment to their community (*not parents, family members or peers*). The letter must either be sent separately by the recommender or be sealed with their signature across the seal.
